Several merit based scholarships are currently available. All enrolled students will be considered.

Career Opportunities

Entry Requirements

The minimum requirement for the Master is a bachelor degree in an appropriate field, such as science, health science, occupational health and safety, and engineering, plus at least two years of work experience.
